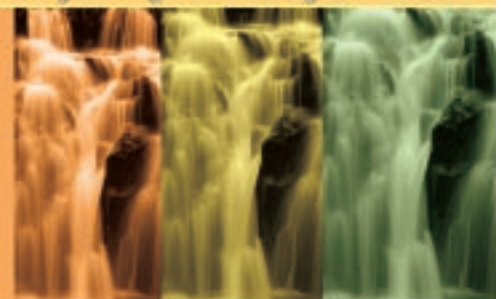

Five Things

God Wants to Do for You

Is there something you want God to do for you? According to His Word, there are several things God wants to do for you — good things that we all desire.

So what's the catch?

The condition is that you must set your love upon Him.

Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

— Psalm 91:14,15

In Psalm 91:14 and 15, there are five things *El Shaddai* — the God who is more than enough — said He will do for the person who sets his or her love upon Him.

God said, “*Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore WILL I . . .*”:

1. Deliver him.
2. Set him on high.
3. Answer him.
4. Be with him and deliver him.
5. Honor him.

We need to understand the importance of the simple phrase “I will” or “I shall.”

A very learned man once addressed a group of us young ministers. This man had an excellent working knowledge of many languages. In fact, when one of the young ministers asked him how many languages he was fluent in, he replied, “Thirty-two.”

This scholar was a translator for the U.S. government during World War I. He was recognized as the leading Hebrew and Greek scholar of his day.

When he visited us, he told us, “There are some things in the Greek — and this would be true in some cases in the Hebrew — for which we have no idiom in the English language.

“For instance,” he said, “in John 14:13, where Jesus said, ‘. . . *whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do . . .*’

the *King James Version* says, in effect, *‘I will.’* In other words, Jesus said, *‘I will do it.’*

This scholar went on to explain, *‘Now, the translators felt they ought to use either ‘I will’ or ‘I shall,’ because that is the strongest assertion you can make in the English language. You can’t say anything stronger than ‘I will do it,’ or ‘I shall do it.’ The translators thought they should make it the strongest assertion that can be made in English.’*

The scholar read the verse to us in the original Greek (it was all Greek to me!). Then he said, *‘Now I’m going to translate that literally for you.’*

This is what that verse *literally* says: *‘If you will ask anything in My Name, if I don’t have it, I’ll make it for you!’*

‘I’ll make it for you!’ And, thank God, He can. Because He is *El Shaddai* — the God who is more than enough!

I was reminded of this incident because in Psalm 91:14 and 15, God says He *‘will do’* the following five things.



1. “I will deliver him.”

Thank God, the God Who is more than enough is a delivering God!

God told Abraham that his descendants would be sojourners in a foreign land for four hundred years, but He promised, *‘I will bring them out with a strong hand.’*

God doesn’t forget His promises: Four hundred and thirty years after Israel’s captivity began in Egypt, God raised up Moses and Aaron to lead Israel out of bondage — and He brought them out with a strong hand. He is still the same delivering God today! He is more than enough!

According to Acts 10:38, *‘. . . God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing ALL that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.’*

Satan is the oppressor. Jesus is the deliverer.



2. “I will set him on high, because he has known my name.”

This point will be studied with the fifth point.



3. “He shall call upon me, and I will answer him.”

God has always been a prayer-answering God. Throughout the Bible, God said, *‘I will answer.’*

Jeremiah 33:3 says, *‘Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.’*

better translation is, *‘Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything.’*

Why shouldn’t you fret nor have anxiety? Because God is the One who is more than enough! He is the All-Sufficient One, the One who never changes, the One who never fails. He is just as able today as He ever was. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever (Heb. 3:8). And He’s interested in *you!* He’s concerned about *you!* That’s why He said, *‘Because he hath set his love*



In Isaiah 43:25 God said, *‘I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.’* Then He added, *‘Put me in remembrance . . .’* (v. 26).

Remind God of His promises! Remind Him of His Word! He is faithful to cause it to come to pass in your life.

The New Testament also proves that God hears and answers prayer.

MATTHEW 7:7,8

7 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

MARK 11:24

24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

JOHN 16:23

23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.

God will hear and answer your prayers! God doesn’t want you to worry or be anxious about a thing. If you’re worried or anxious, you shouldn’t be. Philippians 4:6 says, *‘Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.’* God says, *‘Be careful for nothing.’* A

upon me, therefore . . . I will answer him.’ He didn’t say, *‘If it’s My will, I will answer him.’* He said, *‘Because he has set his love upon Me, I will answer him.’*

When your love is set upon God, you conform your will to be in line with His Word. A man or woman walking in true fellowship with God will never ask anything outside the will of God. And the Word of God is the will of God.



4. “I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him.”

God didn’t say you weren’t going to have trouble just because you’ve been born again and filled with the Spirit. In fact, He rather infers that you are going to have trouble *because* you’re a Christian.

The world is going to persecute you. They’re going to talk about you. They’re going to speak evil of you. And the devil, who is the god of this world, will put pressure on you at every turn.

No, God didn’t say we would never have any troubles. But He did say, *‘I will be with him in trouble.’*

Psalm 34:19 says, *‘Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all.’* Does the Lord deliver us out of *half* of the afflictions, or troubles? No, He delivers us out of *all* of them!



5. "I will honor him."

Whom will God honor?

PSALM 24:3,4

3 Who shall ascend into the hill of the Lord? or

who shall stand in his holy place?

4 He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

You can't cleanse your own hands, and you can't purify your own heart. But you can be cleansed by His blood and stand in the holy place, because *He* has cleansed you and robed you in His righteousness.

God said, "I will honor him" (Ps. 91:15). This statement is similar in meaning to "I will set him on high," which is the second thing God wants to do for us according to Psalm 91:14. These are two things God said He would do for the person who has set his love upon Him.

I would rather have God's honor than have the greatest honor this world can bestow. The world honors politicians, statesmen, generals, educators,

superstars, athletes, and inventors. But if they ever honor a preacher, they honor some humanistic preacher who doesn't believe in the Virgin Birth or the authenticity of the Word of God.

The world as a whole will never honor a real Bible-believing, tongue-talking, divine healing-practicing preacher of the Gospel any more than the world honored Jesus. No, you must compromise if you want to receive the honor of this world. But I would rather have God's honor. The world's honor will pass and fade away, but the honor God bestows will last forever.

Are there circumstances in your life from which you need to be delivered? Are you in a difficult situation and there seems to be no way out? *God promises you deliverance!*

Have you been crying out to God about problems in your life? Do you have prayers that need to be answered?

Thank God, *He will answer you when you call upon Him!*

No matter what you are going through right now, no matter what the doctor's report or news forecast, *God will be with you in trouble.* Not only will He be *with* you in trouble, He will also *deliver* you!

When you set your love upon God and know His Name, He will honor you and set you on high. I don't know about you, but I want to be set on

high — where the devil and circumstances and problems of this world can't touch me!

If your love is set upon God, begin to thank Him today for these five promises that He's given you in His Word. Thank Him and praise Him for delivering you, for setting you on high, for answering you when you call, for being with you in trouble and delivering you, and for honoring you. Thank God for *all* He is doing in your life! 🙏

1917-2003

Broken Arrow, Oklahoma — Rev. Kenneth Erwin Hagin, founder of Kenneth Hagin Ministries and an internationally known preacher, teacher, and author, died Friday, September 19, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was in his 87th year.

Rev. Hagin served in Christian ministry for nearly 70 years and was known as the “father of the modern faith movement.” His teachings and books are filled with vivid stories that show God’s power and truth working in his life and the lives of others.

Rev. Hagin was born on Aug. 20, 1917, in McKinney, Texas, a son of the late Lillie Viola Drake Hagin and Jess Hagin.

Rev. Hagin was sickly as a child, suffering from a deformed heart and an incurable blood disease. He was not expected to live and became bedfast at age 15. In April 1933 during a dramatic conversion experience, he reported dying three times in 10 minutes, each time seeing the horrors of hell and then returning to life.

In August of 1934, Rev. Hagin was miraculously healed, raised off a deathbed by the power of God and the revelation of faith in God’s Word. Two years later, he preached his first sermon as pastor of a small community church in Roland, Texas.

In 1937, Rev. Hagin was baptized in the Holy Spirit and began ministering in Pentecostal churches. During the next 12 years, he pastored five churches in Texas: in the cities of Tom Bean, Farmersville (twice), Talco, Greggton, and Van. In 1949, he began an itinerant ministry as a Bible teacher and evangelist.

During the next 14 years, Jesus appeared to Rev. Hagin eight times in visions that changed the course of his ministry. In 1966, he moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma, where he opened a ministry office. That same year, he taught for the first time on radio — on KSKY in Dallas. In 1967, he began a regular radio broadcast that continues today as *Faith Seminar of the Air*. Teaching by his son, Rev. Kenneth Hagin Jr., is also heard on the program.

In 1968, Rev. Hagin published the first issues of *The Word of Faith* magazine, which now has a monthly circulation of more than 250,000. The publishing outreach he founded, Faith Library Publications, has circulated more than 65 million copies of books by Rev. Hagin, Rev. Hagin Jr., and several other authors worldwide. Faith Library Publications also has produced more than 9 million audio teaching tapes and CDs.

Other outreaches of Kenneth Hagin Ministries include *RHEMA Praise*, a weekly television broadcast hosted by Rev. and Mrs. Kenneth Hagin Jr.; RHEMA Correspondence Bible School; RHEMA Alumni Association; RHEMA Ministerial Association International; RHEMA Supportive Ministries Association; the RHEMA Prayer and Healing Center; and a prison ministry.

In 1974, Rev. Hagin founded RHEMA Bible Training Center USA and in 1976, moved the school and ministry offices to Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, where they remain. To date, RHEMA Bible Training Center USA has 23,000 alumni, and RHEMA Bible Training Centers have opened in 13 other nations: Austria, Brazil, Colombia, Germany, India, Italy, Mexico, Peru, Romania, Samoa, Singapore, South Africa, and Thailand. Together, the 14 schools have more than 28,000 graduates worldwide.

RHEMA Bible Church, pastored by Rev. Hagin Jr., began holding services in October of 1985 on the RHEMA campus in Broken Arrow and has since grown to become a thriving congregation with more than 8,000 members.

Rev. Hagin's daughter and son-in-law, Pat Harrison and the late Doyle "Buddy" Harrison, founded Harrison House Publishers in 1975 and Faith Christian Fellowship International Church in 1977. Both organizations are based in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Until shortly before his death, Rev. Hagin continued to travel and teach throughout the United States and into Canada conducting All Faiths' Crusades and other special meetings.

Rev. Hagin is survived by his wife of 64 years, Lois Oretta Rooker Hagin; his son and daughter-in-law, Kenneth Hagin Jr. and Lynette; his daughter, Pat, wife of the late Buddy Harrison; five grandchildren: Candace and Alan Jackson, "Cookie" and Fred Brothers, Damon Harrison, Craig and Melissa Hagin, and Denise and Don Burns; and eight great-grandchildren: Daniel Kenneth Jackson, Amanda Jackson, Jonathan Doyle Brothers, Whitney Brothers, Cameron Wayne Hagin, Blake Kenneth Hagin, Skylar Eugene Hagin, and Donald Trevor Burns.

Rev. Hagin was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, G. W. and Sally Brumfield Drake, who helped raise him; his mother, Lillie Viola Drake Hagin; his father, Jess Hagin; a sister, Oleta Hawks Armstrong; and two brothers, George Wayne "Dub" Hagin and Forest Glen Patrick "Pat" Hagin.

More than 7,000 people attended a memorial service held at 12:30 p.m. Wednesday, September 24, at RHEMA Bible Church in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. More than 21,000 others watched all or part of the service over the Internet.

Viewings were held Monday and Tuesday, September 22 and 23, in Rooker Memorial Auditorium on the campus of RHEMA Bible Training Center, adjacent to the church. The family received friends from 6 to 8 p.m. each night.

The Supernatural at Work

The Loma Prieta earthquake struck the San Francisco Bay Area at 5:04 p.m. on October 17, 1989. It measured 6.9 on the Richter Scale. Sixty-six people died, 3757 were injured, and damage rose to \$10 billion. Karen Davies was one of 14 RHEMA Bible Training Center students calling the ministry's Word Partners in California to pray with them.

"They kept telling me stories of God's protection," said Karen. "God told one man to take a different route home and because of his obedience, he missed the earthquake. The partners were so thrilled to receive a call and hear that Kenneth Hagin Ministries was thinking about them and praying for them."

Since then Karen has worked behind the scenes at RHEMA's Word Partner Club for 14 years, faithfully dialing phone numbers and speaking with Word Partners all over the United States. The highlight of her job has been talking with and ministering to the partners. "They love this ministry, and they love Brother Hagin. They just can't say enough about him," said Karen.

As she eagerly shared inspiring partner testimonies, Karen included one of her own. Simply stated, she needed a job and God told her to give \$5 a month when the Word Partner Club started. Thirty days later she was hired at Kenneth Hagin Ministries! Karen says other Word Partners have also testified about receiving jobs, finances, healing, and other supernatural help since becoming partners with Kenneth Hagin Ministries.

Karen recalled two instances of people being supernaturally led to Kenneth Hagin Ministries. One woman

from a denominational background called saying she had been increasingly hungry for the things of God, and while in prayer she "saw" Brother Hagin preaching. The Holy Spirit said to her, "This is the man I want you to get your teaching from"! After discussing the incident with someone at her church who knew about Brother Hagin, she called and ordered all of the ministry's books and tapes she could get!

Another man had been saved and filled with the Holy Ghost but wasn't being fed spiritually at his church. In a vision he had while praying he saw a tape recorder and heard a taped message of Brother Hagin preaching! At the end of the tape, the announcer in the vision said, "For further information, call Kenneth Hagin Ministries . . ." and proceeded to give the address and phone number. The Holy Spirit said to the man, "This is the ministry I want you to get your teaching from." This supernatural event inspired him to order books and tapes too.

Karen also recounted a story of a girl who was seriously injured in a car accident. The doctors didn't expect her to live. But her parents kept speaking the Word over her as they had learned from reading Brother Hagin's books. Through faith in God and the power of the Word, their daughter was completely healed! The doctors had also said that the girl could never have children. "But later, I received a picture of her little baby girl in the mail," said Karen, smiling.

"Something stands out about Kenneth Hagin Ministries Word Partners," Karen stated. "Even with myself, when I started giving, I liked it — it was a joy to do it. And I've noticed it's that way with many of Brother Hagin's partners. When

we call them to thank them, they say, 'Oh, it's my pleasure. I love it!' God certainly blesses them with a joy about their giving."

"The Word Partners are sowing seed into a wonderful ministry. I've watched the ministry," said Karen, "and I have seen that the Hagins care about their partners. What an honor it is to represent Kenneth Hagin Ministries by talking to the partners and hearing on a daily basis what this ministry means to people."

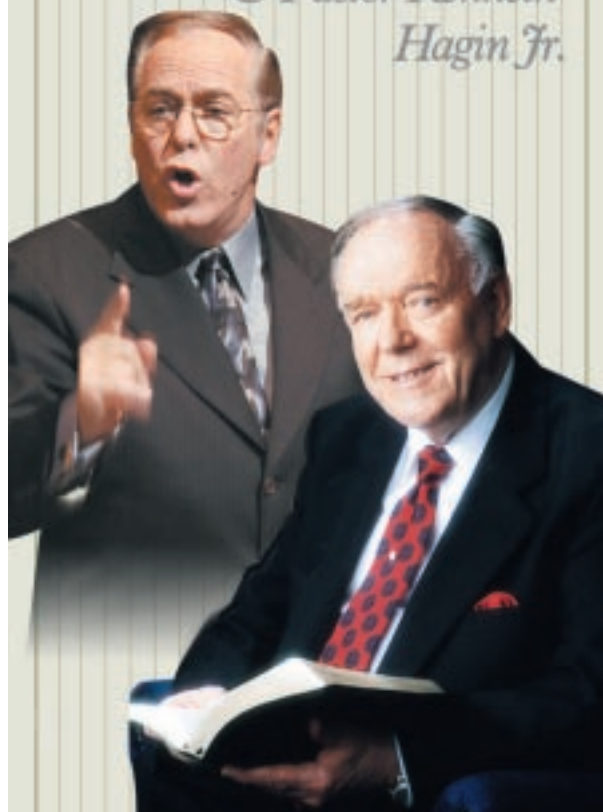

As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings: So the Lord alone did lead him [Israel] . . .
— Deuteronomy 32:11,12

After baby eagles hatch out of their eggs, they have it easy for a while. They sit in their soft, downy nest, and everything that they need in life is brought to them. But one day, things change.

There comes a day when the mother eagle stirs up the nest!

On that day, the mama eagle gets down in the nest and begins to flutter and flap her wings, making those little baby eagles get up and walk around. Then she may start taking away all the soft leaves and downy feathers so the eaglets can't get comfortable — when her young ones try to lie down, the sticks prick them. You see, it's time for the babes to grow up!

You may be at the same place in your spiritual walk. God has provided for you and helped you along. But you've heard enough Word now, and it's time for you to grow up spiritually. It's time for you to start believing God's Word on your own.

Sometimes people reach a place in their walk with the Lord where they wonder why things are not as comfortable as they used to be. Well, it may be that they need to grow up! It may be that God is stirring them just as the mama eagle stirs up her nest and flutters over her young.

That's what the Lord may be doing with you. He's fluttering over you. He's taking away all the downy feathers — all the things in your life

that make it easy to stay spiritually complacent. He's trying to help you move out of your comfort zone and learn how to believe Him for yourself (and not just for *yourself*, but also for *others!*).

Now after a few days of stirring up her baby eaglets and making them walk around in the prickly nest, the mother gets in the nest behind them and flaps her wings until one of the eaglets finally climbs up on the rim of the nest.

But the mother eagle doesn't stop there. With the fluttering of her wings, she deliberately crowds him onto the rim and right off the edge. And there goes the tiny little eagle, *free-falling!*

You may be thinking, *Brother, that's me! I feel like I've just been pushed over the edge of my comfortable life, and I'm free-falling. So what am I supposed to do now?*

You have to do what you've seen other Christians do — use your “faith wings” and start believing God!

That poor little eagle. The only thing he knows to do is what he's seen mama and papa do with those massive wings of theirs every time they came flying down to the nest. So the eaglet starts flapping his little wings — but

it's not helping a whole lot. Then just before he hits the ground, the mama or papa eagle swoops right underneath him and gently bears the little eagle on great wings back to the nest.

I love that. You may be on the ledge, so to speak, looking down on a situation that seems impossible. You may be in midair, trying out your wings of faith for the very first time. It may look as though you're about to hit rock bottom and then it'll all be over. But, friend, I want to tell you that the Heavenly Father will not let you fall (Exod. 19:4)!

Once you really learn to fly, you wouldn't have it any other way!



I want us to read Deuteronomy 32:11 from the *New International Version*.

DEUTERONOMY 32:11 (NIV)

11 Like an eagle that stirs up its nest and hovers over its young, that spreads its wings to catch them and carries them on its PINIONS.

I looked up that word “pinion” in the dictionary, and it means a *bird's wing*. Actually, it's the post-lateral section of a bird's wing. That's where the little bird lands: on the pinion of his parent's wing.

The very next day, the eagles go through the same thing all over again. But this time the eaglet is much stronger and he flies a little bit

longer before he has to be borne up on his parent's wings.

Then after about three days of this exercise, it suddenly happens: The little eagle begins to soar majestically on the wind with outspread wings. He's flying!

The same thing happens when *you* first jump out of the security of your spiritual nest and begin to believe God. It's not too much fun at first. But once you really learn to fly — learn how to trust God in every situation of life — you wouldn't have it any other way!

the nest. And if you're ever going to receive the things you believe God has spoken to your heart and see them come to pass, you must be willing to try your spiritual wings. (You may not even know that you have them, but they are there!)

That little eagle's wings were there all the time — he just didn't know what to do with them! But the mother knew exactly when it was time for her young one to spread his own wings and learn to fly.

After a while, your faith wings become strengthened because you've been constantly exercising them. Then you have no problem at all when you come up against a chasm of tests or trials — because you are used to relying on God's Word. So you jump right out in the middle of that great gulf, knowing that God's Word is going to hold you up and bear you safely to the other side.

Some time around the fifth day, the mama eagle doesn't even have to nudge her young ones out of the nest anymore. Instead, they get up and fly off together!

If you're ever going to soar with the eagles, you must be willing to trust God and to leave the security of

In the same way, you must learn to trust God because *He* knows when it's time for *you* to start spreading your spiritual wings and learn how to live by faith in His Word.

It's all part of growing up spiritually. You can't always remain in the nest of safety. Sooner or later, you must learn how to step out in faith. You must leave the nest and learn to fly!

Sometimes people come to a place in their Christian life where it seems like they just don't know where to go or what to do. It's as if they're stymied in their spiritual growth. And I believe one reason is that they haven't developed their faith.

So you see, you're going to have to make a move. You're going to have to step out of your nest of spiritual dependence and complacency and learn to trust God. Don't be afraid to

The truth is, *you* are the one who limits God in your life!

Let me ask you a question. How big can you dream for God — how much can you believe Him for? Your answer to that question will determine your spiritual altitude, or how high you will soar in life with Christ.

The limit is yours, not

God's. Study God's Word and you will see that God doesn't put any limits on you.

He says, "... If ye have faith ... nothing shall be impossible unto you" (Matt. 17:20). He says, "... What

things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them" (Mark 11:24)! In other words, God says, "You can have whatever you believe Me for according to My Word."

It's up to you how high you will soar in life. So take off the limits and set your sights high in God. Learn a lesson from the eagles: Build your spiritual house on the right foundation — on the Word — and build it strong so it will stand the test. Then don't be afraid to step out in faith and try your spiritual wings.

Learn to believe God and take Him at His Word. Soon, you will find yourself flying over the chasm of impossibilities with nothing underneath you but God's Word. And you will find yourself soaring to greater heights than you ever thought you could attain! 🏹

A nostalgic look at the beginnings of Kenneth Hagin Ministries



Anointed to Preach

Rev. Kenneth E. Hagin recalls how quiet he was as a boy and how that changed after he was born again, healed, and baptized in the Holy Ghost. [Editor's note: This article was prepared before Rev. Hagin's homegoing on September 19, 2003.]

I remember how it shocked my Grandma when I announced, just as a boy, "I'm going to be a preacher."

Grandma said, "Why, son, you can't preach — you can't talk!"

It was true. Because my heart didn't beat right and I would pass out if I tried to exert myself, I had learned in my younger years to sit around and keep my mouth shut. In fact, the year before I became bedfast, Grandpa Drake said one night at the supper table, "I saw your teacher, Miss Bessie Mae Hamilton, today, and I asked, 'How is Kenneth doing?'"

"'Oh,' she said, 'Mr. Drake, he's just like he always was. If you waited on him to say anything, he'd never say anything. In fact, he could miss the class and nobody would ever know it.'"

That put an idea in my mind! I decided to try that out. I had only two classes in the afternoon — Miss Bessie Mae's and another — so two or three times a week I'd play hooky and go to the movie.

You know, they never did miss me. They never counted me absent. That's how quiet I was in class. Of course, after I got saved, I quit doing that. When I went back to high school after my healing, I never missed a day.

After I was saved and healed, I began to preach as a young Baptist boy. I knew I was called to preach, and the anointing to preach would come upon me. I didn't have any anointing to teach, and I didn't like teaching.

I'd pray, study, and prepare sermon outlines — and I've got nearly all of them still. I don't preach some of them anymore, but they represent all the light I had then. (God will bless you because you're walking in all the light you have.)

The first time I preached, I preached 45 minutes. Some beginners go 10 or 15 minutes. I went 45. And I've been going ever since!

For a number of years I was a preacher — and, oh, I could preach! I was a preaching machine! I like that anointing! When it came upon me, I'd preach so hard and fast, the congregation would say, "Slow down! Slow down! We can't get half of what you say, you go so fast."

I didn't have the baptism in the Holy Spirit then, but I had the Holy Spirit *in* me, and an anointing would come *on* me because I was called to that office. (In the Old Testament, too, the anointing came *on* people to stand in certain offices.) I could relate some phenomenal things that happened when the anointing to preach came upon me as a young Baptist boy preacher.

One Sunday night I was preaching an evangelistic-type sermon from James 4:14, where James asks, "*For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.*" I'd been preaching about 15 minutes, anointed by the Holy Spirit,

when the power of God came into that church auditorium and filled it like a cloud.

I could not see a single member — I was in the cloud. I could hear the sound of my voice, but I didn't know one word of what I said. For 17 minutes — I looked at my watch — I couldn't distinguish a word.

Finally I could see people on the first three rows of seats. Then the anointing began to go away. It was just like a cloud lifted from the whole group. I didn't say anything about it; I closed the service normally.

Several days later I asked a very spiritual old gentleman who had been there, "Was anything different about the service Sunday night?"

"Well, why?" he replied.

"Well, you tell me if there was, and then I'll tell you why."

He said, "Well, the only thing was that people have been talking about it all over the community. It seemed like your face shone. It didn't look like you — it just looked like the face of an angel."

Then I told him about it. I told him I hadn't known one word I said for the last 17 minutes of the service, the anointing was upon me so. That's all a work of the Holy Spirit: the anointing and the glory cloud.

After being baptized in the Holy Spirit, I entered into a greater dimension of the power of God, and that anointing to preach increased. There is a scriptural basis for this: Elisha desired a double portion of Elijah's anointing. Elijah was anointed by the Holy Spirit to stand in the office of prophet, and Elisha had a double portion of that anointing — a greater anointing, in other words, to stand in the same office.

A COMPLETE *Miraculous* OVERHAUL

“Why is my baby so blue?”

Krista asked the doctor. He had no answer. Mark 5:36 came to Bill’s mind, “Be not afraid — only believe.” Bill and Krista Anzevino began to speak only two words, but they were words full of absolute assurance: “*We believe!*” These parents knew, with a certainty based upon Jesus’ words, that their newborn son would live!

The hurried effort to clear little Andrew’s air passages for more oxygen to reach his lungs began in the delivery room — but to no avail. Eventually, Andrew, within his first few hours in this world, was life-flighted from Beaver, Pennsylvania, to a children’s hospital in Pittsburgh. Doctors there discovered Andrew was born with a condition known as 22Q11 (a genetic abnormality in which a portion of the 22nd chromosome is lost). He was subsequently diagnosed with Di George Syndrome. Associated with this syndrome are multiple irregularities (potentially up to 185 of them), often present at birth.

“Andrew was so bad off,” Bill said, “the doctors wanted his last rites to be read to him before he left for the children’s hospital.” As tests were done, more complications emerged. His chances of survival were slim to none. But Bill and Krista remained solid, resisting the emotions that rose up as they watched their precious son go through the

discomfort of his condition and the necessary medical procedures. They told the doctors, “Do whatever you need to do” and “we *still* believe.”

Before he was *one day old*, Andrew’s known complications included tetralogy of Fallot (a heart condition) and a partial thymus gland, resulting in an almost non-existent immune system, much like that of a person with AIDS. He had no left pulmonary artery! He could not suck, swallow, or breathe at the same time; therefore, he could not eat and had a feeding tube in his stomach. On top of all that, at 16 hours old, Andrew had his first open-heart surgery.

From the first minute of Andrew’s life, in the midst of a most treacherous storm, Bill and Krista spoke God’s unfailing Word to each situation as it arose! God faithfully

met them with His healing power every time!

On and off in his first year of life, Andrew spent 4 months in the hospital.

“When he contracted chicken pox and it spread to his lungs, we spoke the Word over Him,” said Bill. “We looked at the X-rays again and there was nothing in his lungs. He was fine. At first, Andrew had no left pulmonary artery. The next echo-sonogram showed it was as big as a thread. Then later it was 2.5 centimeters, and by the time Andrew was 9 months old, it had grown to normal size. We spoke the Word to that artery and over his heart condition. Then at 10 months, the doctors tested Andrew’s once terribly weak immune system and discovered it was completely normal!”

Andrew was born June 25, 2001, and is just over two years old now. He takes no medication. He runs and plays like other toddlers. He goes back to the doctor once a year just for a checkup. 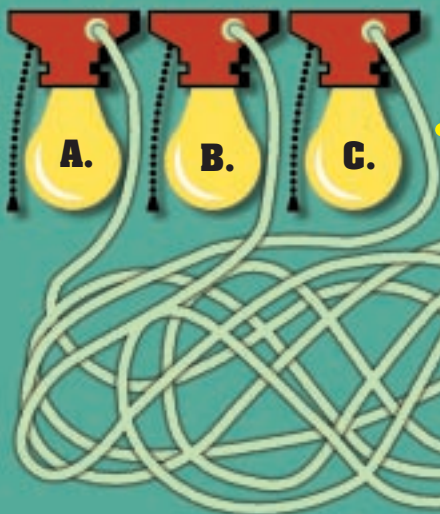

Check Your LOVE Gauge



Do you know what a fuel gauge is? It's a gauge on a car that lets the driver know how much fuel is in the fuel tank. If the fuel is low, then you go to the gas station to fill the fuel tank up. Without fuel, the car will not work. Love is much like fuel. **Without love, your faith will not work.** According to Galatians 5:6, "faith works by love."
